








Number of COVID-19 diagnosed people nationwide (weekly)

Number of COVID-19 diagnosed in Niigata Prefecture (weekly)




※ The first confirmation of COVID-19 in Niigata Prefecture was on February 29, 2020.

Number of people diagnosed with COVID-19 per 100,000 population by health center jurisdiction






Number of people diagnosed with COVID-19 per 100,000 population by health center jurisdiction



confined spaces, crowded areas, long conversations







- Wearing masks
